Monday Munch Club

Valuable culinary life skills are due to be passed on to the younger generation at a series of fun Monday Munch Club cooking classes being launched in the New Year.

Youth engagement specialists The Door will be running 12 weekly sessions from 3.30pm – 5.30pm every Monday from 9 January at Cam Youth and Community Centre, Woodfield, focusing on cooking, nutrition and budgeting.

Called the Monday Munch Club, the classes will highlight and celebrate cooking opportunities falling within the 12-weeks, such as Chinese New Year, Valentine’s Day, Shrove Tuesday, and Ramadan.

The project is the idea of Cam Parish Council and funded by taste and nutrition experts Kerry Foods who are based at Draycott Mills in Cam.

Community Governance Review

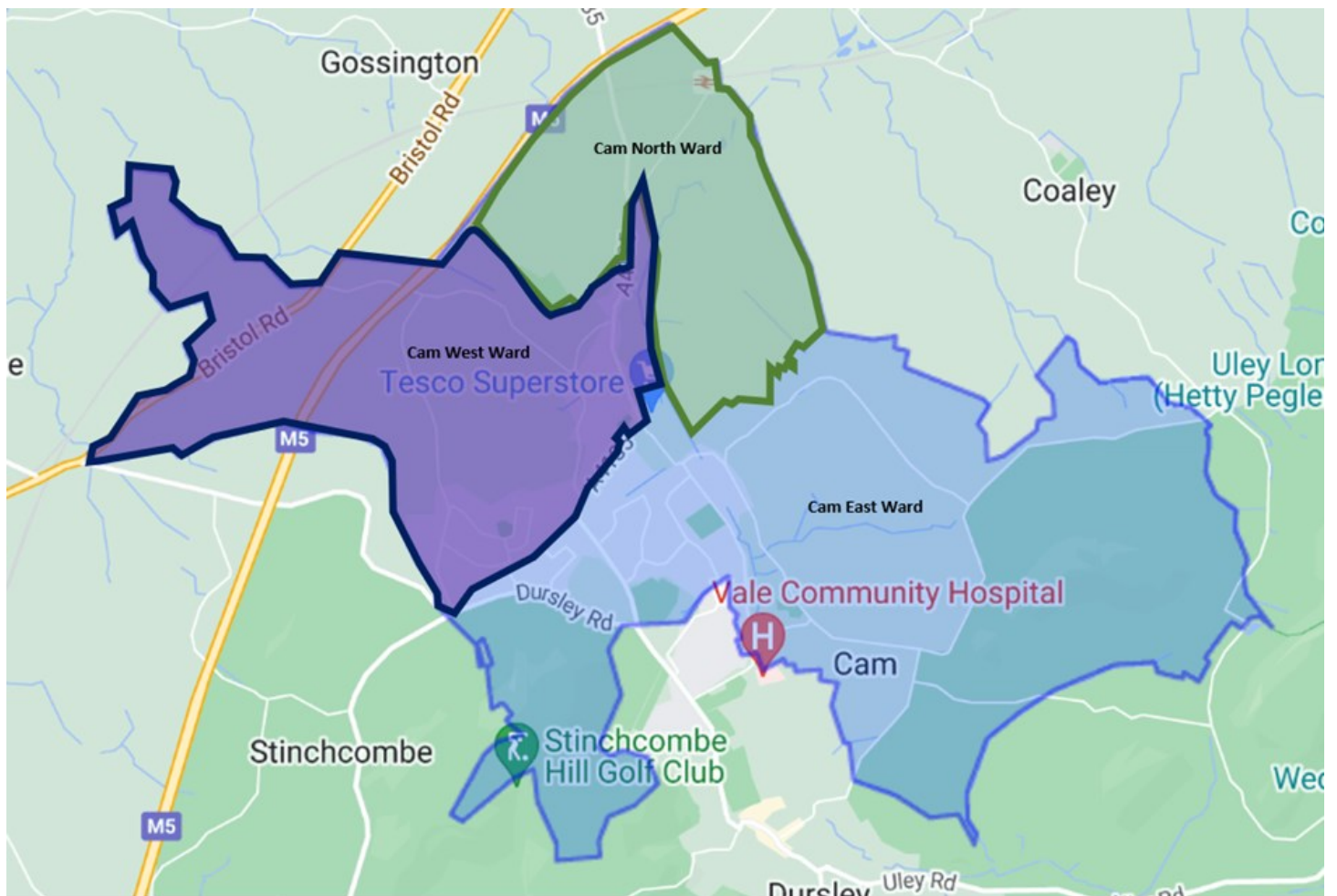
Stroud District Council has announced that Cam should be included in a small-scale Community Governance Review looking at specific areas of the district.

There are currently two wards within Cam: Cam West (9 seats) and Cam East (7 seats). A working party explored options and opinions around increasing the seats available to better reflect the huge amount of growth within the parish. It put forward the following recommendation to Full Council which was approved as the parish's preferred way forward. This will be reviewed by Stroud District Council before any decision is made.

1. Create a new ward to encompass Box Road and the new development along the river Cam, including land allocation PS25 and the land allocation at Draycott
 - Suggest the name of the ward should be 'Cam North Ward'
 - Suggest 2 Councillors for this ward with a future review to increase the number of Councillors once more housing is built
2. Cam West (division 1) slight boundary change to allow for creation of new ward
 - Suggest 8 Councillors for this ward
3. Cam East (division 2) slight boundary change to allow for creation of new ward
 - Request an increase from 7 Councillors to 8 Councillors for this ward

Through March 2023 to April 2023, phase 2 of the consultation will take place: following consideration of the consultation responses and publications of the draft recommendations Stroud District Council will work directly with areas to see what residents think. Changes to the recommendations may be made depending on the responses and evidence received.

A final report will be published in July 2023: following Stroud District Council's consideration of the final report, an Order will be made to give effect to any changes to local parishes which will come into force on 1 April 2024.



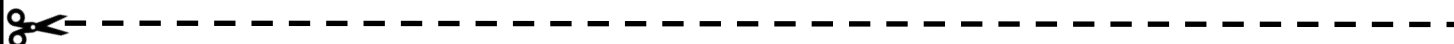
