The telephone kiosk containing a defib at St. Georges was managed by a committee of community volunteers. Over the past few years, the commitment from the committee has dropped off leaving the sole responsibility down to 1 individual. She has requested that the Council take it back and continue with the maintenance and monthly checks of the defib.

They did their own fund raising and currently have enough in the bank for 2 years' worth of funding – they pay an annual fee to Community Heartbeat of £150 to cover the cost of replacement pads and batteries.

Clerks recommendation is that the council absorb this responsibility and transfer the fund from the account to the council.
