

District Councillor's Report September 2nd 2026

Since our last report we have been busy knocking on doors across our wards to listen to resident's concerns both locally and nationally and addressing the local issues raised.

Most of our focus has been on varied but largely housing related case work.

Cllrs Kinnison, Hamilton and parish councillor Tina Walker held a first Councillor's surgery at Woodfields. Our regular district councillor surgery schedule is at Cam PC – 10am-12midday on the first Thursday of every month, all welcome.

The intention is to hold surgeries in both venues in future – details of when the Woodfields surgeries are going to be held will be available on the Parish Council website.

The Woodfield area scores poorly for biodiversity so a ward walk was arranged with Rebecca Charley who is the SDC strategic lead for Nature Recovery & Biodiversity. There will be focus on trees and other nature friendly design in the longer term but starting at first with a project looking at planters in the area and what could be achieved with grants and partnerships with local businesses.

A big focus has this summer has been Cam Peak Fest which will be held at the Cam Sports Club on Saturday 5th of September 12-11:30pm.

Fabulous festival flags have been designed and decorated by the local primary schools and the youth club.

Doors open at 11:30am and last-minute tickets will be available on the door, we hope you will bring family and friends to support and enjoy the festival.
